Please remember that, **from next week**, all children must have the correct PE kit to enable them to join the PE sessions. Our kit is simple and cheap to buy:

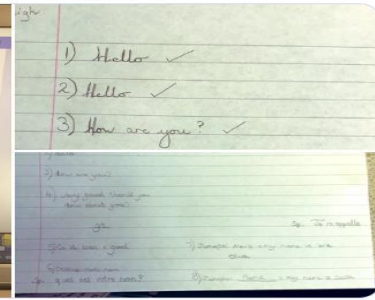
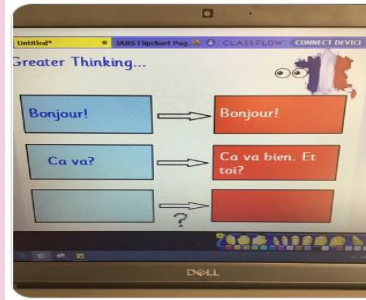
- Plain white T shirt
