UNIVERSAL OFFER

Work set over a week will combine a range of activities and formats. They may include:

- Reading activities
- Phonics
- Spellings
- Writing
- Story time

Foundation stage children will have a range of interactive activities exploring our world, our families and the arts.

Reception

Reception class will use Tapestry. We will share your home learning via this app. The app can be accessed via any device (phone, laptop, tablet). Our on line learning will be pre recorded allowing you to access it when most convenient – we understand that the children will need support with this and that your time will be limited! Each day there will be a phonics video and linked activities shared, a writing activity (dough disco, squiggle and wiggle, handwriting), and a story time. There will also be a Maths video and follow up activity shared from White Rose Maths Hub. In addition there will be a Padlet of activities to dip in and out of throughout the week around the current topic – this will include creative tasks, outdoor activities and physical challenges, as well as links to lots of other learning opportunities. Reading books will be available online via Tapestry that will be matched to each child's reading stage and we will send a password home in this pack. We do ask that you register that you have accessed each days home learning by clicking 'like' on the Tapestry post, or uploading a comment or video from home. Each week we will organise a Friday 'drop in' – inviting children to an online video to keep in touch and have some fun!

Year 1 and Year 2

Both of these year groups will use Seesaw. Every morning, we will email you a link to a Google Meet Registration so that we can say hello and answer any questions. Then our teachers will upload video lessons and activities. Each child will have the opportunity to share their work by taking a picture of it, t=making a video or voice recording and sharing it with the teacher. You can work through the activities in any order you choose. We have given you a rough guide to times to help you plan your day.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ You must stay on mute until you are invited to speak.■ Only share screen content, if the teacher has agreed.■ You must wear suitable clothing, as should anyone else in your home.■ You should find a suitable quiet environment, for example, in a shared part of the house i.e. not in bedrooms or bathrooms; and the background should be blurred if possible and if not should be appropriate.■ Speak kindly and respectfully.■ You are expected to attend all teacher scheduled lessons, unless the teacher has been previously notified.■ ALWAYS make sure you leave the Meet. Always double check and get in the habit of closing your device when not in use, to prevent the camera from working regardless.■ <u>It is not permitted to record lessons.</u>■ <u>Please keep your camera on if you have one!</u>■ <u>Please respond if you are spoken to by the teacher!</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ All Google Meet sessions will be led by the teacher whilst in the school setting if possible.■ Teachers will not allow attendees to join before host and they will keep a list of attendees. Teachers will ensure that attendees are muted as they join the meeting.■ Teachers will make expectations and meeting conduct clear regularly including the school rules.■ Teachers will ensure no one else is on view from the camera, wear suitable and appropriate clothing.■ The teacher has the right to remove a student from a Google Meet if their behaviour is not in line with the school behaviour expectations. We will contact parents.■ Only hold meetings with a manageable amount of children and during the school day.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Please DO NOT film the session on another devices this is a safeguarding and GDPR issue.■ Parents have ultimate responsibility to make sure students not only attend, but follow the correct protocols when online Google Meetings are scheduled with teachers.■ Please help your child set up and access the Google Meet lesson using the link posted into the distance learning google classroom/other platform used by the school and their assigned school Gmail account.■ Please make sure that your child is ready 5 minutes before the advertised start of the meeting, to ensure that you are on time and that you don't delay the meeting and are not locked out.■ Please ensure your child is appropriately dressed for meetings. We would expect pupils to be dressed as though it was a non-uniform day.■ Please ensure other family members are appropriately dressed and out of camera shot and do not contribute to the video call.■ Please discuss with your child the appropriate way to behave in the meeting - in the same way as if they were in school with the member of staff. If a child is behaving inappropriately, the school may need to suspend their school google account temporarily.

Marking and feedback

During live lessons marking and feedback will be given immediately. When using Seesaw and Tapestry, teachers will aim to respond to all work in a timely fashion. Here is a list of staff emails.
