Early Bird Breakfast Club

At Breakfast Club we strive to offer excellent value for money offering a healthy breakfast and child care in a safe and secure environment.

Useful information:

- Breakfast Club is run by Miss Bardy and Mrs Smallwood.
- Breakfast club runs from 7:30am – 8.40am daily in the Tree Tops Building. Breakfast is only served till 8.30am so children are ready to go to their classrooms on time for the start of the school day.
- The daily cost of Breakfast Club is £2.50 per session. (If you are entitled to a concessionary rate, the cost will be £1.25)
- Children are offered a daily healthy breakfast of cereal, toast, crumpets, teacakes, fresh juice, milk, fruit, yoghurts and seasonal foods (Halloween breakfast, pancakes etc).
- All children can clean their teeth at school if you wish them to.

We really hope that this will be a great start to the day for your children and we do hope that we will be providing a valuable service for you. The Breakfast Club will provide a chance for children to meet before school in a safe, relaxed and fun environment.
